CAMPING

For people who have chosen to camp and bought tickets there are two campsites:

Family & Quiet Camping: By quiet, we mean that we would not expect people to be singing and making noise late into the night. We will have security onsite to ensure that people get the best opportunity for a good night's sleep.

General Camping: This campsite is closer to the main race village, there will also be a security presence here but we are less concerned about the noise.

Camping Car Access: Campers have been issued with two car parking permits, one for each area; please display the sticker for the campsite you would like to use as you arrive at the race. Marshalls will then direct you straight to your campsite. **(note:** Car access to the family & quiet camping area will be limited while the races start as they cross the access road, if you are affected by this you will be able to move your car later).

Wristbands: Please ensure all of your group wear camping wristbands (enclosed in your pack).

Facilities: The deer park has limited facilities, there are toilets and water. There are no showers. Hopefully, you will be able to get rid of the worst of the filth in the tub of love.

Campfires: Campfires are not allowed in the deer park. You are welcome to have BBQ's; please ensure they do not burn the grass.

Caravans & Motorhomes: Caravans and Motorhomes are welcome, however, there is limited hard standing and we have no electrical hookup points. We have plenty of recovery vehicles so if the ground is soft you won't be there until Christmas!

Alcohol: We do not have a licensed bar and will not be supplying alcohol. You are, of course, welcome to bring your own.

Entertainment: We have an acoustic band playing a set on Saturday night around a communal campfire and you are very welcome to join us.

Catering: There will be some food concessions in the evening and again at breakfast, if you do not want to cook your own.

Times: Access to the campsites will be from 12pm on Saturday 29th June.
